What is the Experimental Aircraft Association (EAA)?

The EAA is “The Spirit of Aviation!” The EAA started in the 1950’s as a small association to promote the homebuilding of aircraft, but has since evolved into a large international aviation organization of over 250,000 members encompassing everything from homebuilt (“Experimental”) aircraft to Vintage Aircraft, Ultralight flying machines, Aerobatic aircraft, Military aircraft (Warbirds), and more. The EAA also sponsors the “Young Eagles” program to give children the opportunity to experience flight in a light airplane. The new chairmen of this EAA program are Captain

“Sully” Sullenberger and First Officer Jeff Skiles who successfully landed USAir Flight 1549 in New York’s Hudson River with no casualties! Previous Young Eagles chairmen have been Chuck Yaeger, Cliff Robertson, and most recently, Harrison Ford.

Can I build and fly my own aircraft?

Yes, absolutely, You Can! Many thousands of people have done exactly that! As a bonus, after the aircraft receives its FAA airworthiness certificate, you can qualify to maintain your own aircraft via a “repairman’s certificate” if you have built at least 51% of the aircraft!

What is the best way to discover more about the EAA?

Step One is to join the EAA international organization. Go to www.eaa.org, click on “Member Services,” and click on “Join.” An individual annual membership is \$40 and includes the monthly “Sport Aviation” magazine. Step Two is to join a local EAA Chapter like EAA Chapter 448 here at Cable Airport. EAA Chapter 448 has monthly meetings in the EAA Chapter Hangar on the north side of Cable Airport. At the local chapter level, you’ll find friendly EAA members who can answer your questions and guide you to your flying dreams!

EAA Chapter 448 Information

Our chapter, EAA 448, is located here on the grounds of Cable airport. We were established nearly 35 years ago, and have been supporting local aviation ever since. We participate in Young Eagle flights, where we recruit pilots to give children the opportunity to experience flight. Our most recent Young Eagles event had three airplanes flying a total of 15 children. It was a great experience to see the kids have fun, and come back from each ride with broad smiles on their faces.

EAA chapter 448 also has a builders hangar where several experimental planes are currently under construction. This is a great opportunity to learn from other pilots who are also building experimental aircraft.
